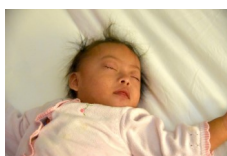
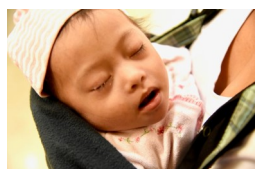
Child #93: Zanick from Jamaica
